DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

Sugarbush Gap, Windsor NY

From the North and West, take Interstate 81 South or Rt 17 east. Stay on Rt 17 east
when Interstate 81 goes off south. Take EXIT 77 toward WEST WINDSOR. Turn
RIGHT onto PLACE Rd. At the top of the hill, turn SLIGHT LEFT onto TRIM ST.
Go 4.2 miles and Turn RIGHT onto WILLIAMS RD. take the first right on Sugar
Bush Rd. (0.9 miles) and turn into the first driveway on the right.

From the East, take Rt 17 to EXIT 79 WINDSOR. Turn right on Chapel Street and
Right on Rt. 79. After Rt 17 East entrance, turn RIGHT on KENT Street. Turn left on
WILLIAMS Rd. (the first left hand turn possible). Take the first right on Sugar Bush
Rd. (0.9 miles) and turn into the first driveway on the right.

From the South, take Interstate 81 north to EXIT 230 - Hallstead/Great Bend. Turn
left at ramp and right on Rt 11 north through Great Bend. On the outskirts of Great
Bend, turn RIGHT on RANDOLPH Road. Go 1.5 miles to a one lane bridge and take
the next right (at the state line), HONEY HOLLOW Road. Go 4 miles to WILLIAMS
Rd, bearing right when Anne Rd goes off to the left. Turn left on WILLIAMS Rd 1.2
miles. Turn left at an old white farmhouse on SUGARBUSH Rd. and and turn into the
first driveway on the right

Exhibitor Information

REPLACEMENT COST OF \$150 for injured stock. Stock is considered injured if (1) it is unable to continue in the Trial (2) blood is drawn or (3) in the opinion of the Committee, veterinary services are reasonably required. The Committee's decision is final.

LIMITS: Entries will be limited to 9 Course D sheep runs, 9 Course A sheep runs, 6 HT or PT sheep runs and 15 duck runs. Entries will close when these numbers have been reached. Competitive runs will have priority over Exhibition only entries. Alternate entries are limited to 3. Entrants on the alternate list must check in with the secretary 30 minutes before the commencement of their class and must run in their respective classes if present and provided with the opportunity to run. Entry fees will be refunded in the event an alternate is available. Requests to move-up must be given to the secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

ENTRIES CLOSE: October 30, 2019- 5:00 PM, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. Mail to SNKC Herding Secretary c/o Liz Navickas, 317 Sienko Rd., Hallstead, PA 18822; 607-727-5939. **Waive signature for express mail or FedEx delivery.** Drawing order at 8:00 PM., October 30, 2019 at above address. **Telephone, telegraph, fax, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.**

ENTRY FEE: \$45 for sheep Course A and test runs, \$50 for sheep Course D runs, \$40 for duck runs, AKC recording fee of \$3.00 included. Returned checks will be charged \$30 NSF fee. Make out a separate entry for each dog indicating which class entered. Print or type legibly, **make checks payable to SNKC.** All fees in U.S. Funds. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.

The Susque-Nango Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs' physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against The Susque-Nango Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of the level in tests and in catalog order as listed in the level in trials.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.
